Sale of Scrap Equipment & Metals

The Cargo Handling Corporation Ltd is inviting sealed bids from potential buyers for the purchase of scrap equipment on an 'as is where is' basis. Presently the following scrap equipment (Terminal Tractors, Trailers, Forklifts, Reachstackers etc.) and metals are available for disposal and are located at the CHCL, Mer Rouge, Port Louis (Mauritius Container Terminal, Multipurpose Terminal and Quay E). The list of equipment and metals available for sale may be seen on the CHCL's website: www.chcl.mu

A site visit has been scheduled on **Tuesday, 07 November 2023 at 10.30 Hours** at the above locations.

Interested buyers are requested to provide full names and ID Card by email: registry@chcl.mu and subject matter should be clearly written "Site Visit- Sale of Scrap Equipment & Metals" or submit the mentioned document at the Registry, 2nd Floor, CHC Building, Mer Rouge, Port-Louis by latest on Monday, 06 November 2023 at 15.00 Hours. Buyers shall have to present Access Pass to be allowed inside the port premises.

The offer price shall be quoted for each category of the scrap per ton on "as is where is basis".

Bids, in sealed envelopes, addressed to the Officer in Charge, Cargo Handling Corporation Ltd and clearly marked "**Sale of Scrap Equipment & Metals**" should be deposited in the Tender Box located in the Tender Room, 2nd Floor, CHC Building, Mer Rouge, Port Louis not later than **Wednesday, 15 November 2023 at 13.30 hours (local time)**. Offers received after the specified closing date and time will not be considered.

Bids should remain valid for a period of **120 days** after the closing date and be accompanied by a bid security amounting to Rs 70,000.00 for Lot A and Rs 10,000.00 for Lot B, in the form of a Bank Cheque. Bids without a bid security will be rejected.

Note:- It is responsibility of the bidder to cut the metal parts (where required) for safe transportation only. Bidders shall comply with all laws, regulation and safety rules inside port premises including access pass and hot work permit. Bidder shall bear all charges towards gatepass/hot work permit/weighing the empty/loaded truck. The scrap metal loaded on trucks will have to be weighed and receipt to be produced accordingly for each trip.

The successful bidder shall be required to effect advance payment for each consignment prior to taking delivery. All scrap equipment & metals shall be removed from CHCL within 60 days from the date of award.

The CHCL reserves the right to accept, or reject any offer and to cancel the above exercise at any time prior to award without thereby incurring any liability to affected bidder(s).
